

How to play a game of gaelic football

Equipment

- GAA ball
- Football boots
- GAA gloves
- Cone (For Goalkeeper)

Players: You will need 7-15 players

How to play

- 1 Find a pitch that has GAA goal post around your area.
- 2 Make teams and pick a captain. The captain is the only player that can talk to the referee but if the captain is injured or doesn't play the vice captain has to talk to the referee.
- 3 When the game starts, there will be 2 players in the middle and the other 2 mid fielders will have to stay at the sideline where the opposition's coach is. When the ball is thrown in to the middle the other 2 mid fielders can run in to the middle.
- 4 Points, Goals and 2 pointers
When you have the ball and you shoot into the goals and it goes in it will count as 3 points, if the ball goes over the bars however it will count as 1 point, but if you score from the big arc which is 40m out you will get 2 points.
- 5 Free Kicks
If the goalkeeper saves the ball and it goes past the line it will be a 45 which is from 45 metre out from the goals.

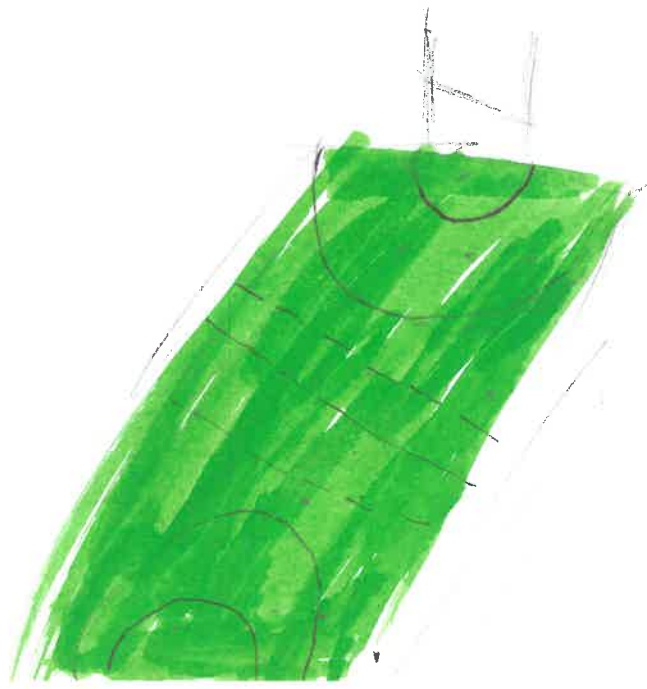
6 If you get a freekick from outside the 20metre line you can solo and go. A solo is when you drop the ball onto your foot and kick it back into your hands. A solo and go is you take 4 steps solo and take another 4 steps and the defenders can't tackle you until you take 8 steps.

7 For a goal kick kick, if the goalkeeper kicks the ball to you and you catch it past the 20m line you can call a mark by putting your fist up in the air.

8 Positions

If you are a defender you can't go past the midfield line and if you pass it will be a free for the other team.

9 If you are the goalkeeper you are not allowed to come out of your box.



How to Play Bulldog Royale

Equipment

- 2 tags per person - 4
- Approximately 32 cones to make a 16x16m square
- 1 velcro belt per person - 2

Players

At least 6

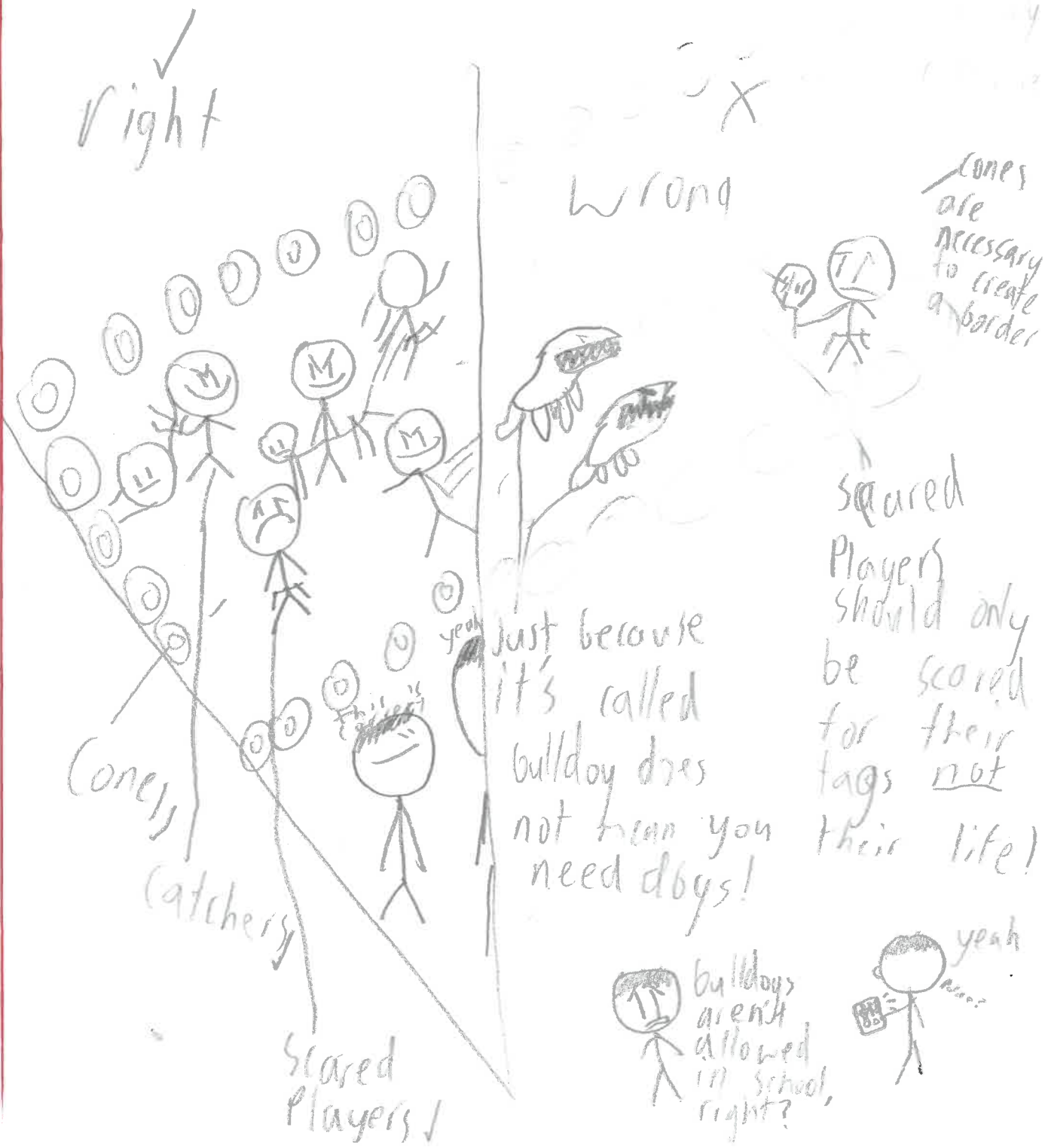
Method

- 1 Create a 16x16m square using the cones.
- 2 Retrieve two players to volunteer to catch people.
- 3 Give each player who isn't a catcher a velcro belt and two tags.
- 4 Place everyone who isn't a catcher in the square.
- 5 Place the catchers in the square, the game has now started.
- 6 If you lose both your tags you're now catching people.
- 7 When all but one have lost both their tags then that one person is the winner.

How to play Bulldog Royale.

Notes

- If the smaller players can't get their belt on, help them.
- If there are no volunteers to be on, get the two oldest.



Grass Tag

None needed

- 1) Find a large patch of grass.
- 2) Gather at least three people.
- 3) Choose one person to be a catcher. If nobody wants to be on then pick the oldest.
- 4) Everyone starts to run around the grass.
- 5) If there is a patch of bar mac and you run on it, you're out.
- 6) If the catcher is on the bar mac nothing happens.
- 7) If the catcher touches you're on.
- 8) The winner is the last person thats not on.



How to play Grass tag

What you need:
no tools needed.

- ① You need a patches of grass.
- ② You need 13 or 14 people and 1 catcher to play.
- ③ If you get touched by the catcher you're on
- ④ You will need to stay on the grass or you're on the catcher also has to stay on the grass.



How to fish / live bait

What you need

- A small rod but not too small
- A reel
- A big rod
- A reel
- Small hooks
- Big hooks
- And bait typically worms
- A scissors
- And a net

Directions

- First you're going to want to attach your reel to your small rod.
- Then put your eyes on the small rod.
- When you have that done grab the top of your fishing line.
- After you've done that grab your hooks and put it through your line then wrap it around nine times and put it through your hole at the bottom.
- Cut the tag off at the bottom with your scissors.
- Then put your worm on the hook.
